

**South Lyon Band Parents Association In-House Michigan Progressive Rules:**

- A coverall pattern will be required to win the progressive jackpot bingo game.
- Winning the progressive jackpot will start at 50 numbers on the first occasion. If no winner, the number will increase by 1 at the next scheduled bingo occasion.
- The starting prize awarded to the winner of the progressive jackpot bingo game on the first bingo occasion will be \$300.
- If the progressive jackpot prize is not won within the set number of allowable calls for this occasion, the game shall be played to its conclusion for a consolation prize of \$50.
- If the progressive jackpot prize is not won within the predetermined number of allowable calls, the entire prize amount shall be carried forward to the next scheduled bingo occasion.
- When the progressive jackpot prize has been carried forward from a previous bingo occasion, the new prize amount shall include the entire amount carried forward, plus 50% of the card sales for the progressive jackpot bingo game from the current occasion.
- The progressive jackpot prize shall be awarded to the player or split between the players who are first to complete the coverall pattern within the predetermined number of allowable calls.
- A consolation prize of \$50.00 will be awarded on each bingo occasion in which the progressive jackpot game is played, except on the bingo occasion in which the jackpot prize is won.
- The consolation prize shall be awarded to the player or split between the players who are first to complete a coverall pattern on each bingo occasion, regardless of the number of calls in excess of the predetermined number of allowable calls required to win the progressive jackpot bingo game.
- The progressive jackpot bingo game shall be played only on specially marked bingo 3 face sheets. These sheets will be date stamped with the current date.
- Players must purchase regular bingo sheets in order to be eligible to purchase progressive bingo sheets.
- Sales of Bingo Cards will be limited to the first 80 patrons.
- Progressive Bingo will be played at the following time intervals:
  - 14 seconds when allowable calls are 50-54.
  - 16 seconds when allowable calls are 55-57.
  - 18 seconds when allowable calls are 58-60.
  - 20+ seconds when allowable calls are 61 and up.
- Before the beginning of the Progressive Jackpot Game the South Lyon Band Parent Association will announce the following information:
  - The maximum number of allowable calls in which the player must complete a coverall pattern in order to win the progressive jackpot prize on that occasion.
  - The prize amount offered to the winner of the progressive jackpot game and the consolation prize for that bingo occasion.
  - The date the next bingo occasion will occur in that particular progression if the jackpot is not awarded.
- The progressive jackpot posting will be a notice at the hall, on the South Lyon Band Parents Bingo webpage, and emailed to any patron that would like to be added to an email list.
- The jackpot prize shall be awarded by a check.
- The doors will not open before 4:30 p.m.
  - The handicap door will be the official entrance.
- All "State of Michigan Gaming Rules" and "State of Michigan Progressive Bingo Rules" apply.

## House Rules

1. All persons on gaming floor must be at least 18 years of age.
2. The ball seen on the screen is not in play until the caller calls the ball.
3. Players must call "BINGO" when the number is called, and make sure a worker or caller recognizes their Bingo before the next number is called.
4. Bingos must include the current number in play.
5. Bingos will not be recognized after a game is closed.
6. The only official board is the rack in front of the caller, not the light board.
7. In the event of simultaneous Bingos payouts will be divided equally among all winners.
8. All players must purchase their own cards.
9. You must have a verification ticket with the number of books purchased visible at all times.
10. Splitting Bingo sheets is prohibited and invalidates any winner.
11. Bingo sheets purchased cannot leave the Bingo hall.
12. Bingo sheets are sold at random; players cannot select their own sheets.
13. Make sure that cell phones or other noise making devices are shut off or kept on silent mode.
14. All Sheets must be marked with daubers only: no ink pens, crayons, markers, etc.
15. Prize money will be adjusted according to the attendance at the onset of the "Early Birds" and again at the onset of the first "regular game." (See pay sheet)
16. Profane, vulgar, or abusive language will not be tolerated at any time. The harassment of workers or callers will not be accepted. Violators will be asked to leave.
17. If a player must leave and cannot return due to an emergency his/her cards are to be turned in to the chairperson. No other players may play their cards.
18. All State of Michigan Bingo rules apply.
19. Only charity gaming tickets sold by our organization will be redeemed. (State of Michigan Charity Gaming rules apply)
20. It is the responsibility of the player to keep all winning charitably game tickets and specials in a safe place. The organization and its workers are not responsible for any lost items.
21. The organization reserves the right to cancel due to inclement weather or equipment failure. Cancellations will be posted on the hall door, or persons may call John the SLBPA Bingo Chairperson at 734-834-4158.
22. Workers may cover players Bingo card(s) if a Bingo player needs to take a short emergency break. The organization or worker will not be held responsible for an error in the game.
23. In the event of power failure, equipment failure, loss of heat, or any other reasons beyond control of the organization, a refund of 25 cents will be issued for each unused Bingo sheet.
24. Handicapped players may be aided by workers. Workers are not required to assist but may help upon request of player.
25. Bingo players that come in late must buy a full priced book.
26. All players must abide by the House Rules and the State of Michigan Gaming Rules.
27. All problems, questions, and/or disputes will be resolved by the Bingo Chairperson. Their decision is final.
