## House Rule's

1. All person-entering hall must be at least 18 years of age.
2. **Bingos must be called on last ball called.** Player must call bingo when the number is called, raise their hand, and make sure a worker or caller recognizes their bingo before the next number is called. Bingo will not be recognized after a game is closed. The ball seen on the screen is not in play until caller, calls the ball.
3. All players must purchase their own cards
4. You must have a verification ticket with the number of books purchased visible at all time.
5. Reserving of seat is allowed up to 30 minutes prior to start time.
6. Visitors are not allowed.
7. As a courtesy to players there will be no use of cell phone, pagers, or noisemakers during bingo. Please make sure that they are shut off or kept on silent mode.
8. All Papers must be marked with dabbers only, no ink pens, crayons, etc.
9. The only official board is the rack in front of the caller, not the lighted board.
10. Chairperson reserves the rights to adjust prize money according to attendance. (See pay sheet)
11. No food or beverages other than the hall concessions will be permitted for consumption.
12. Profane, vulgar, or abusive language will not be tolerated at any time. **The harassment of workers or callers will not be accepted. Violators will be asked to leave.**
13. Our organization reserves the right to refuse admittance of customers within reasonable bases of House Rules and Michigan State Bureau of Lottery Rules.
14. If a player must leave due to an emergency he/she cards are to be turned in to the chairperson. No other players may play their cards.
15. All state of Michigan bingo rules apply.
16. Only charity gaming tickets sold by the organization will be redeemed. Winning ticket should be redeemed by the end of the bingo session.
17. It is the responsibility of the player to keep all winning charitable game tickets and specials in a safe place. The organization and its workers are not responsible for any lost items.
18. The organization reserves the right to cancel due to inclement weather or equipment failure. Cancellations will be notified on hall door, or person may call Bingo chair person at 248-437-5046.
19. Workers may cover bingo card if a bingo player needs to take an emergency break; the organization or worker cannot be held responsible for an error in the game.
20. Refund policy due to cancellation during bingo session that has already begun, power failure, equipment failure, loss of heat, or any other reasons beyond control of chair personnel. A refund of 50 cents per each unused bingo sheet per sheet.
21. Handicap players may be aided by workers. Workers are not required to assist but may help upon request of player.
22. Bingo players that come in late must buy a full priced book.
